Notes for Ebenezer Weeks Robinson:

Rev. Ebenezer Weeks Robinson, the eldest child of Rev. Ralph Robinson and Anna Weeks, b. May 1, 1812 probably at Granville, Washington County, NY. He was undoubtedly named for his mother's two-year younger brother, Ebenezer Weeks, who died in his senior year of study at Middlebury College, VT. Ebenezer d. at Washington, DC Apr. 8, 1869, Æ 57.

On June 21, 1838 at Franklin, Norfolk County, Mass., Ebenezer was m. by Rev. E. Smalley to Sarah Bacon Adams, dau. of James Adams, Esq. and Lucy Fairbanks. She was b. at Franklin, Mass. June 27, 1809 and d. at Washington, DC Feb. 19, 1904, Æ 95. In their marriage record, Ebenezer is stated to have then been a resident of Freetown, Mass.

Ebenezer is badly misrepresented, or incompletely represented, in many sources describing him, his family, where his children were born, and the family's whereabouts before 1870. This especially in the 1850 federal census when he is called Emmons Robinson and his wife Sarah as Eliza. In his early career as a minister of the Congregational Church, he apparently spent little time in one place, perhaps providing supply for vacant pulpits or for ministers who were temporarily away from their churches. The family was residing at Lebanon, Conn. in the June 1840 census; at Lisbon, Conn. in the June 1850 census; and at Bethany in New Haven County, Conn. in the June 1860 census. Traces of Ebenezer are also found in recorded marriages at Canterbury, Lebanon, Lisbon and Windham, Conn. However, the greater part of his actual ministerial work was performed at the Newent Congregational Society at Lisbon, Conn. While there, he and wife Sarah raised their children in a parsonage formerly the house built by Rev. David Hale of Coventry, Conn., brother of American patriot Nathan Hale.

According to the 1925 Robinson Genealogy:

"Rev. Ebenezer Weeks Robinson graduated from Hamilton College, NY, and the Theological Seminary at Auburn, NY. He was installed as the pastor over churches in Massachusetts and Connecticut. In March, 1864, he went to Washington and entered the Paymaster General's office and Freedmen's Bureau in the employ of the government's War Department, also at Howard University until his death. A portion of this period he preached to the soldiers at Cliffburn Barracks, Convalescent Camp, Meridian Hill, DC. devoting himself not only to the spiritual but the temporal welfare of the soldiers. He was also a teacher and superintendent in several Sunday and night schools for the colored people, and strove most diligently to elevate them morally and intellectually as well as in their material condition.

He was an efficient mover in the establishment of the First Congregational Church in Washington, DC. and was known as the "Father" of that church. He was an earnest and faithful preacher of the Gospel, earnest and untiring in his efforts to win souls to Christ, and fearless in his attacks upon the evils of the times. He rendered great aid in the compilation of "Contributions to the Ecclesiastical History of Connecticut" while a resident of that State. He was an occasional contributor of articles and items to the religious press, and wrote some poetry."

Perhaps his best known claim is having proposed, organized and then almost single-handedly compiling and editing the 1861 published Contributions to the Ecclesiastical History of Connecticut, a work that lists every former and then existing Congregational parish and church in Connecticut together with a short pastoral history of those churches. Astonishingly, the Congregational Church Library at Boston has no compiled necrology for Ebenezer.
