From Find A Grave:

Abigail (Dane) Faulkner, gained fame (or infamy) as a convicted witch in the Salem Witch Trials. Her very young daughters and sister were also accused. ABIGAIL only escaped hanging by being pregnant with son Ammi Ruhamah Faulkner. The mass hysteria of the witch hunt was over by the time of his birth. The Puritans being such merciful people did not hang pregnant women. ABIGAIL did finally receive a pardon and some financial restitution years later.

Notes for Ammi Ruhamah Faulkner:

He moved from Andover to Acton, Mass., (now South Acton) and purchased, in 1733, the place still (1937) in the Faulkner family. The house was originally the Garrison House, built as a refuge for the settlers in times of Indian raids but there is no record that it was ever used for that purpose. He built the mills which, for over two centuries, have been known as the Faulkner Mills. His wife, Hannah, was the daughter of James and Hannah Abbott Ingalls. Both are buried in Woodlawn Cemetery, Acton.

He settled right into Acton's town affairs after moving there in 1738. In May of 1738 he was chosen to the committee to settle Acton's first minister, Rev. John Swift, and to arrange his salary. Sixteen years later, when Parson Swift's salary had to be reassessed because of fluctuating prices, he was also on the committee to settle that. Although he entered into town affairs only as a selectman for two years, he helped Acton's early growth by operating the mills at Acton's commercial center - Mill corner is S. Acton was then called. Shortly after he purchased the place, he added a grist mill to the already existing fulling and saw mills.

- Notes for Ammi Faulkner:
Ammi was born in Littleton, MA on 25 Feb 1733/34 to Ammi Ruhamah and Hannah Ingalls Faulker before they moved to Acton. He was the 5th child and 3rd son of their 4 sons and 2 daughters. He fought in the French and Indian War in 1755. He was a Private in Capt. Asahel Wheeler's co., Col. John Robinson's regt and also in Capt. Gleason's co., 4th regt. in the Revolutionary War. He is listed in the Massachusetts Society of the Sons of the American Revolution: Soldiers and Sailors Whose Markers Have Been Designated By the Marker of the Society, prepared by Henry A. May, 1901. Collection of the Harvard College Library
He inherited the east half of The Faulkner House in South Acton from his father in 1756, and helped run the Faulkner Mills there. His brother, Col. Francis Faulkner inherited the west part and summoned the Acton Minutmen on the night of 18-19 April 1775 by firing 3 shots from the west window of the Faulkner House. This was before the Battle of the North Bridge in Concord and "the shot that was heard around the world" and started the Revolutionary War. The Faulkner House, built in 1710 and the oldest house left in Acton, is now a National Historical Landmark. Ammi was married to Obedience (mnu) about 1760, but they had no children mentioned in any records or his will.
